**Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

**Sunday:** Mass at 10.00am

**Tuesday:** Church open from 10.00 - 11.00am for private prayer.

**Thursday:** Feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. Holy Hour from 6.00 - 7.00pm.

This will include Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, prayers for the parish, the Rosary and will end with Benediction.

Canon Tom will be present and will be available for Confessions.

There will be a permitted maximum of 30 in the Church: this is 30 units, so people on their own, couples or people in the same household would count as one unit. Please do not attend if you or anyone in your household has any symptoms of Covid-19. Hand sanitiser is provided and you must use it when you enter and leave the Church. All surfaces will be wiped down after each time the Church is open. It is very important that you respect social distance while in Church and follow any given instructions. Mass books will not be available until further notice. Holy water stoups are not currently in use.
