**The Selsey Venture Bus** is back in operation. Many of you who are already members will know that it is a registered charity operated by volunteers and was started in 1967 to assist over-60s or disabled residents of any age to take part in the life of the town. It offers a door-to-door service and is equipped to carry walking aids and wheelchairs.

At present it is providing transport to Sunday morning church services and shopping in Selsey on Tuesday and Friday mornings. It hopes in time to get back to its regular service of transport to the many clubs and lunch meetings, Thursday trips to Chichester and the monthly Saturday visit to Church Norton Cemetery.

Those who wish to use this service have to register as a member of the Venture Club. There is a one-off charge of £15 for the remainder of this year, to 31 March 2022. The full subscription is expected to be £20 for the following twelve months. Please ring 01243 605115, 9.30-11.30am and 2.30-4.00pm Monday to Friday for further information.
